There have been 9.3 breaks per 1000' on the water main that will be replaced. The main breaks cause a reliability issue due to outages. Breaks also require a boil notice to be implemented after service is back on line. This project will correct and replace any potential lead services within the area of the project.

C: PROJECT SCOPE (Describe the work to be completed) 2000 character limit.

This project will replace 6" cast iron water main on Julia Ave, Heikes Ave, Hornwood Dr, Greenhill Rd, Folsom Dr, and Knollview Pl, in Harrison Township with 8" ductile iron water main with all appurtenances. The project will also remove old fire hydrants and replace them with new hydrants with closer spacing. The project seeks to replace the water main which has excessive breaks and has exceeded it's useful life. The pipes being replaced have broken at a rate of 9.4/1000'.

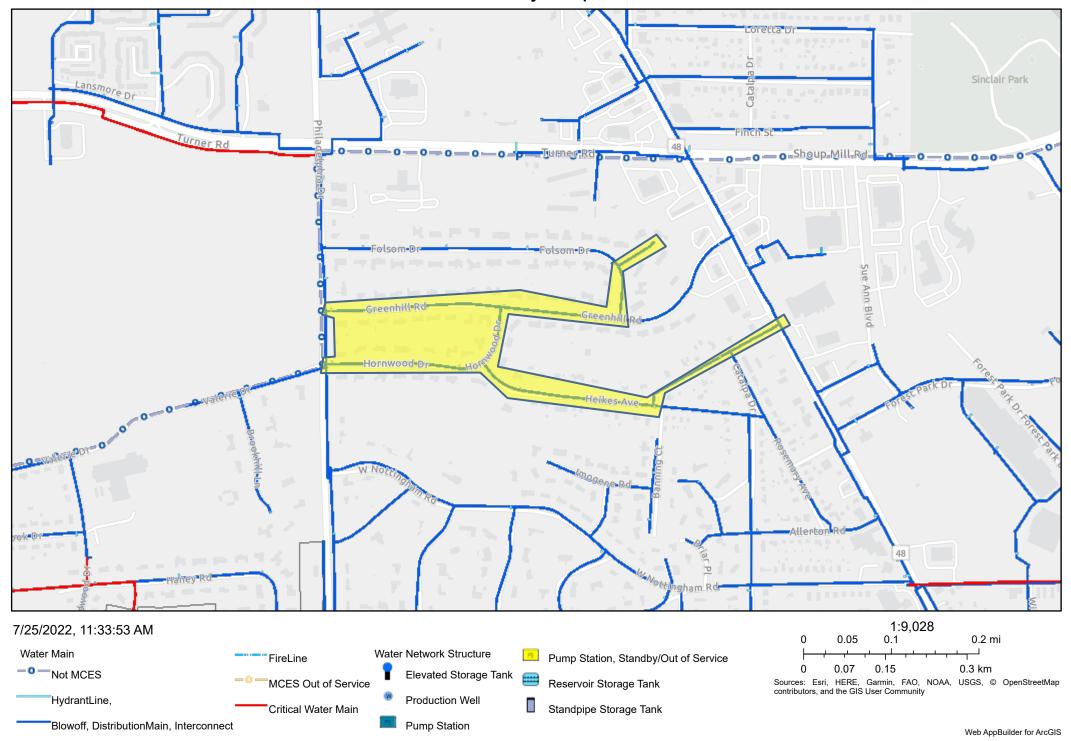

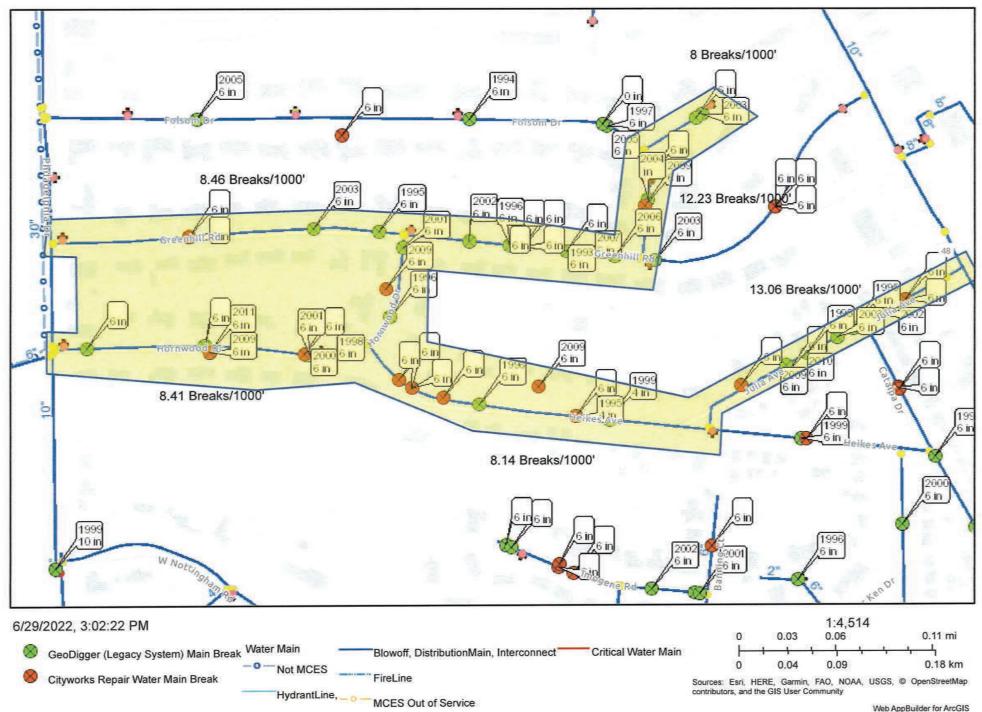
